

United Nations assisted refugee camps contain some 17,500 Miskitos and Sumos who began to flee the Sandinista regime in late 1981.

Some 7,000 to 9,000 Miskitos who fled the Sandinistas have taken refuge on the northern side of the Wanki River. They receive no assistance from United Nations relief agencies.

About 50,000 Miskitos and Sumos have been displaced by the Sandinista war and more than 100 villages destroyed.

Without Indian participation, a 1880 World Court decision dismembered the Miskito Nation by creating a Nicaragua-Honduras international boundary along the Wanki (Río Coco).

Miskito and Rama peoples include continental shelf waters, reefs and islands as part of their sovereign territories.

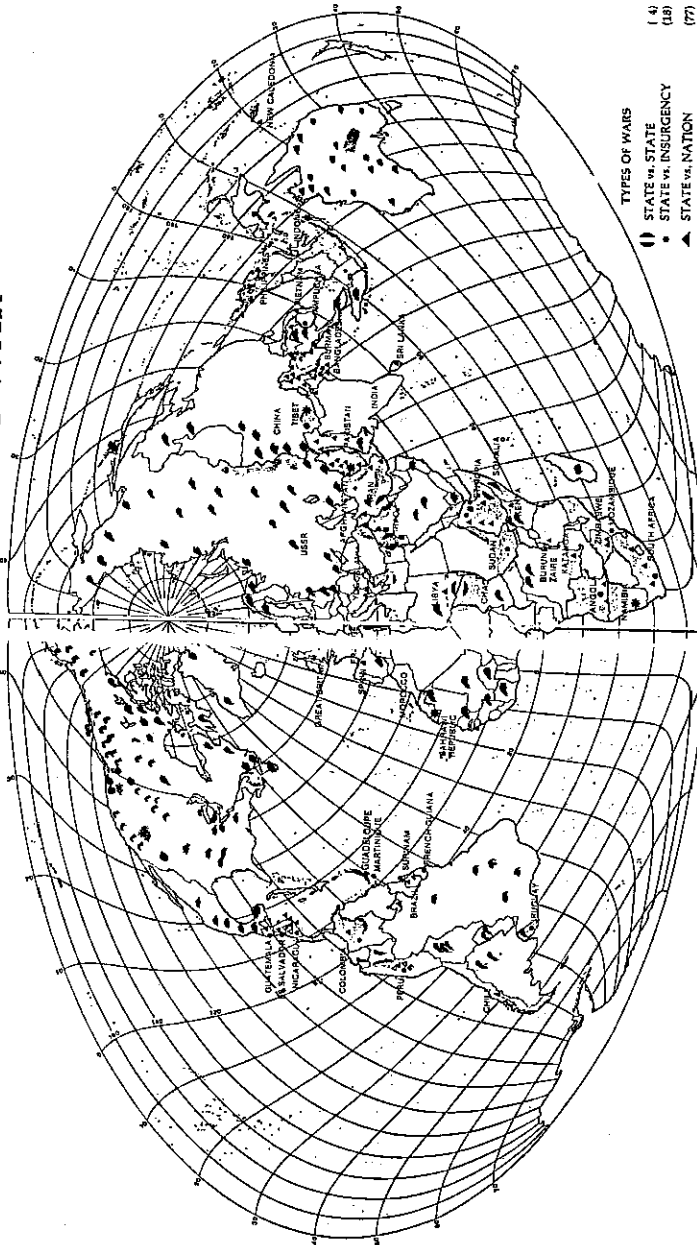
The eastward advancing Ladino agriculture frontier has created several Sumo "outliers" and is steadily cutting into all three Indian Nations.

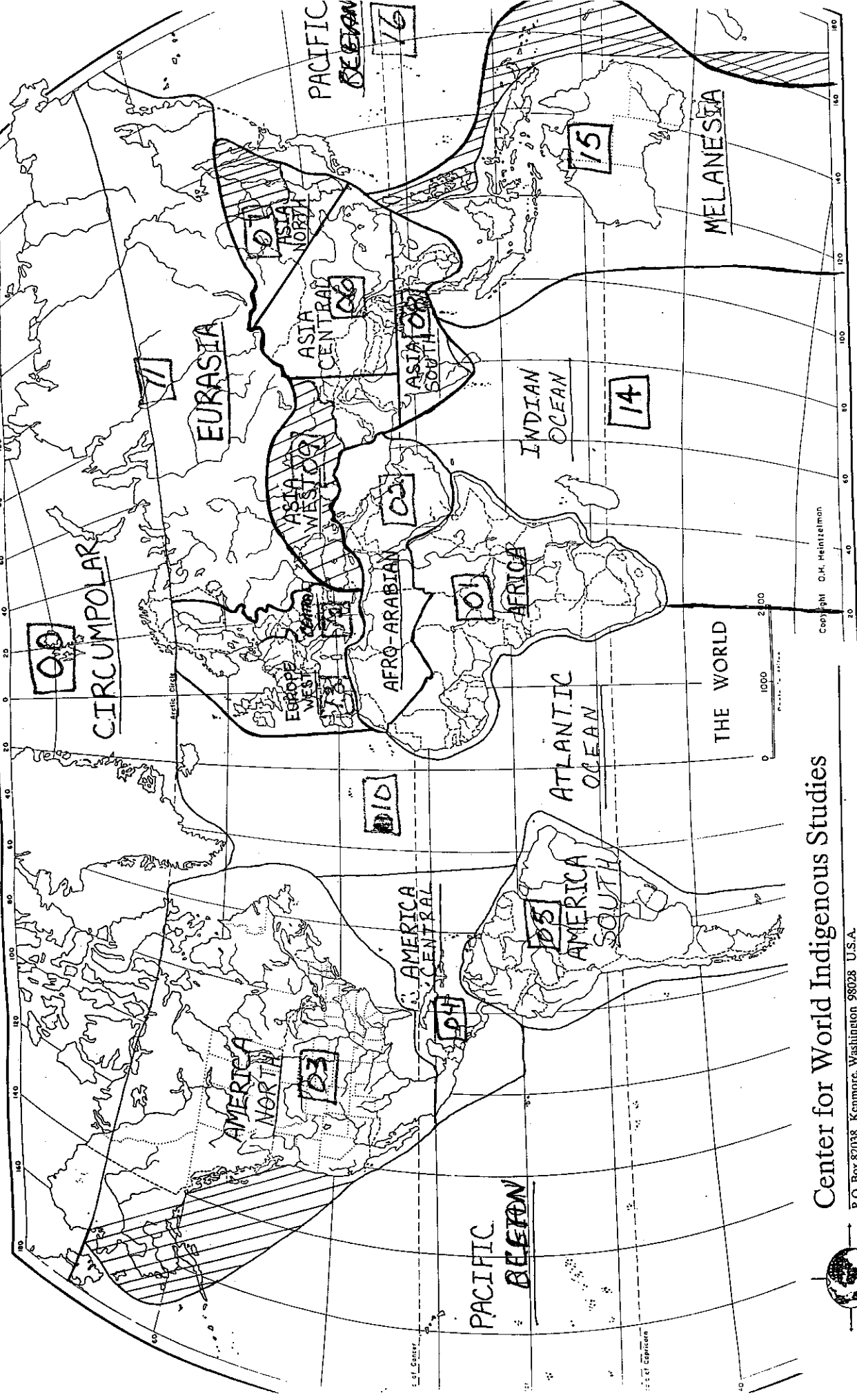

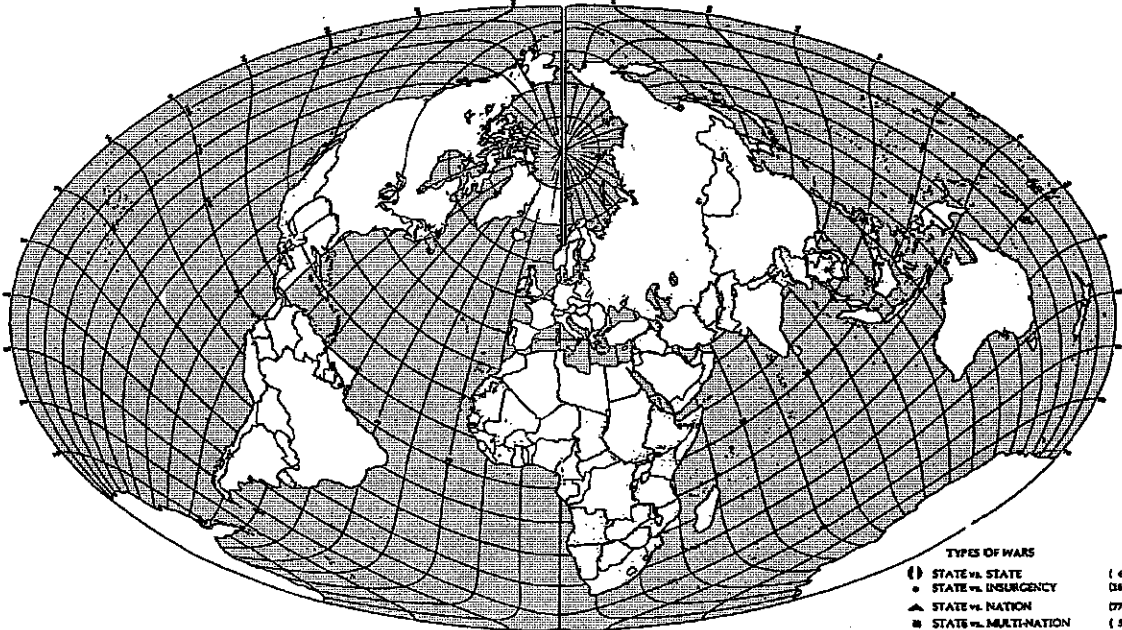

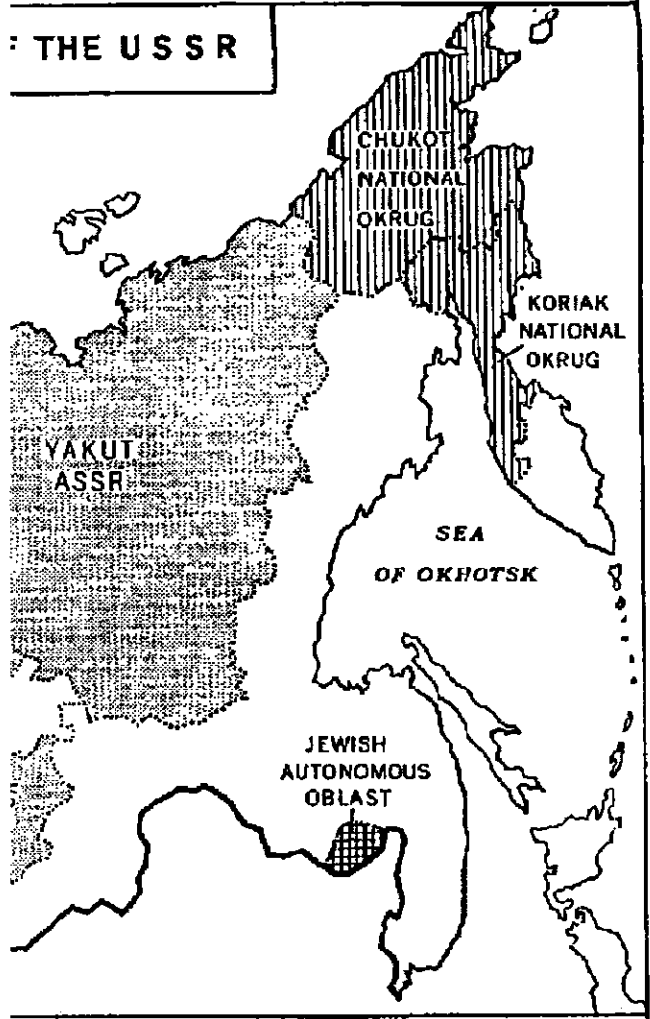
